

Charges for TAY Non-Members Administrative – Logistics – Clergy

Clergy and staff of TAY are engaged to provide service to TAY members and their families. When a non-member who is not a shivah-degree* relative of a member, dies, the family of the deceased is to *pay Temple Adath Yeshurun* for administrative-logistics fee for allowing the staff to provide administrative-logistic support as well as allowing clergy to officiate. “Officiating” means conducting the funeral service at the funeral home, synagogue and/or graveside. The fee is due before the funeral.

There shall be one fee amount for administrative support and for officiating at the service; an additional amount is due if TAY clergy is requested to officiate requiring meeting with the family and writing a eulogy.

These administrative – logistics fees for funerals are waived for TAY members

This policy does not require or preclude an honorarium given directly to participating clergy.

Ownership of a plot at the TAY cemetery by non-members does not cancel the need for the payment unless a shivah-degree relative is a member.

Amount of the payment due TAY will be set and reviewed at least every five years.

Exceptions may be made to the standard charges by the Executive Director in consultation with the Rabbi.

*Shivah-degree relatives are: parent, spouse, child.

Suggested beginning fees:

Administrative-logistics and minimal Clergy Officiation [no eulogy]: \$500.

Administrative-logistics and Clergy write eulogy and officiate: \$1000.
