- Torah reading
- Carry Torah
- Lift or dress Torah

NON-JEWISH OR JEWISH PARENT

- Offer personal blessing for child, speech, poem
- Stand with spouse during *aliyah*
- Present child with *tallit*
- Read a translation of the *shehehiyanu* or other prayer

OTHER NON-JEWISH RELATIVES

- Open/Close the ark
- Prayer for Peace
- Read a translation of Hebrew prayers or offer a personal prayer in consultation with the rabbi
