During this season, we make *teshuvah* — “repentance” or “return.” We seek to cleanse ourselves and access the inner core of who we are. That path of return brings us to wonderful new vistas, but the journey is frequently filled with difficulty: feelings of regret, shame, anger, sadness, and longing.

Through this journey, we often visit memories from the past, encounters for which we wish we had shown up differently, moments that we long to revisit, relationships we yearn to repair and rekindle. To the living, we turn in confession, with an outpouring of the heart. To the dead, we have opportunities to do the same. During the cemetery service, during Yizkor, and during private visits to the graves of loved ones, we grant ourselves rituals to address our departed family and friends and open our hearts in *teshuvah*. *Teshuvah* in this case does not need to mean repentance and confession of wrongdoing. It can simply be an expression of deeply held emotions: our longing, words of love perhaps not offered during their lives, acknowledgement of the tremendous impact they made on our lives. *Teshuvah* is a return to the sacred core of these cherished relationships.

During this season of return and reconnection, may we appreciate the sacred bonds that link us to the living and the dead. May we offer deep gratitude for the blessings our family and friends bring us in life, and even in death.

**INTRODUCTION.** Yizkor is a time set aside to formally include in our thoughts and prayers family and friends who have passed away. Though Yizkor is recited on each of the festivals, on the High Holy Days we may feel a special connection to those who have played a significant role in our life's journey. The themes and somber ambience of the Yom Kippur service make this day especially appropriate for contemplating life and death. Thus, in reciting Yizkor, the veil between the worlds of the living and the dead becomes more transparent, less opaque. May the memory of those we recall be a blessing in our lives.

**WHAT ARE HUMAN BEINGS** מַה־אָדָם. The verses in this passage come from Psalms 144:3–4, 90:6, and 90:12.

צְדָקָה TZ'DAKAH/CHARITY

The Yizkor service was called *seder matnat yad*, the service of expressing generosity on behalf of those who have died. That name comes from the closing line of the Torah reading for the final day of the pilgrimage festivals (when Yizkor is recited): "Every person giving a gift according to the blessing they have received from Adonai" (Deuteronomy 16:17). Offering charitable gifts and performing acts of justice, love, and care in memory of those who have died provide us with ways of honoring their memory and continuing their influence for good.

Dear God,

You know my heart.
