# *A Message from Rabbi Saks*

It is relatively easy today to find examples of people or nations profaning the name of God by using His “authority” to oppress others. Those who would have us believe that they know exactly what God wants them to do, especially when it concerns harming others, give religion, in general, a bad name. Nevertheless, this should not serve as an excuse to deny God’s existence. We need God – in whatever form we determine that Higher Power to be. A true and honest faith in God enables one to fully realize his or her human potential. In addition, it can help us to avoid the idolatries of the day – money, power, and especially dangerous – worship of the self.

No one ever said faith in God is easy. Especially after we experience the death of a loved one, we may have many questions: Do I question my God? Am I sometimes angry with Him? Do I often challenge Him? Do I ponder His ways? Of course! But I cannot ignore Him or pretend that He does not exist, for then I would have no hope; nor would Humanity. The power of God is carried through us, His children.

That power, and the faith that exists with it, is especially present at Yizkor. The remembrance of our loved ones, family and friends, the Martyrs of Israel, including the Six Million, offer us the opportunity to connect the past with the present, using their memory as a source of strength to perform acts of lovingkindness in order to promote peace in the world. A tangible expression of this strength, such as a charitable gift to TAY, in memory of your loved ones, is most appropriate.

**INTRODUCTION.** Yizkor is a time set aside to formally include in our thoughts and prayers family and friends who have passed away. Though Yizkor is recited on each of the festivals, on the High Holy Days we may feel a special connection to those who have played a significant role in our life's journey. The themes and somber ambience of the Yom Kippur service make this day especially appropriate for contemplating life and death. Thus, in reciting Yizkor, the veil between the worlds of the living and the dead becomes more transparent, less opaque. May the memory of those we recall be a blessing in our lives.

TZ'DAKAH/CHARITY יִצְדָּקָה.  
The Yizkor service was called *seder matnat yad*, the service of expressing generosity on behalf of those who have died. That name comes from the closing line of the Torah reading for the final day of the pilgrimage festivals (when Yizkor is recited): "Every person giving a gift according to the blessing they have received from Adonai" (Deuteronomy 16:17). Offering charitable gifts and performing acts of justice, love, and care in memory of those who have died provide us with ways of honoring their memory and continuing their influence for good.
